### **INFORMATION COVID-19 : PROCEDURE IN CASE OF POSITIVE TEST**

Madam, Sir,

According to the recommendations we have received from Smittskydd Stockholm (Stockholm Infection Control) and the Swedish authorities, we are informing you of the procedure to follow if an LFSL student tests positive for COVID-19:

- If your child tests **positive** for Covid-19, you must inform Lycée Français by email via: [covid19@lfsl.net](mailto:covid19@lfsl.net).
- The person tested positive must be isolated: The student in question must remain at home 7 days after the test result with a return to the LFSL without symptoms. We advise siblings, even if asymptomatic, to stay at home for 7 days as well.
- The family and/or the person tested positive must inform their close contacts. People who have had close contact with the student should be alert to possible symptoms and it is advisable to go for testing.
- The possible switch to distance learning for a class or level could only be made in case of a cluster and for a limited period of 7 days.
- Distance learning is thus envisaged on the basis of 3 simultaneous cases in the same class only.

For information, a follow-up table is set up in order to follow the evolution of the contaminations of the students tested positive to Covid-19 within the LFSL.

Information will also be given by the LFSL to the families of a class where a student would be declared positive for COVID-19.

As a reminder, the sanitary and pedagogical protocol is on the LFSL website available to all.

The Smittskydd Stockholm insisted on the fact that given the health measures implemented in schools, it is generally not the school environment that is the most at risk. Contamination between students would be more likely to occur outside of school hours. The recommendation is therefore to respect all barrier gestures and social distancing outside the LFSL.
