FINANCIAL REGULATION

Approved by the Board on 14 March 2024.

(As the Fondation Lycée Français Saint Louis de Stockholm is an institution governed by Swedish law, the Swedish version of the financial regulations shall prevail).

The Lycée Français Saint Louis (LFSL) is a not-for-profit school, which is financed by contributions from the municipalities for each enrolled pupil (known as the "school allowance"), by school fees paid by families and by certain grants from the French State, via the Agency for French Education Abroad (AEFE), such as expatriate staff salaries, part of the salaries of seconded staff and grants for certain investments.

Initial enrolment fee

- The enrolment fee is charged as soon as a place is offered and confirmed by the school, and only for the first enrolment at LFSL. It entitles the student to full enrolment until the student leaves the school. This fee is non-refundable in case of cancellation or if the student leaves the school.
- A child's enrolment becomes effective only when the school has formally confirmed the offered place and the applicable fees have been paid in full. Unpaid enrolment fees may result in the loss of the offered place at the school.

Re-enrolment fee

- A re-enrolment fee will be charged for all children who have left the LFSL for more than 6 (six) months and wish to be re-enrolled.

School fees

- School fees are reviewed and set annually by the school board. Current school fees are available online on the school website and are attached to this document. Any changes to these fees will be communicated to parents/guardians in writing.
- To ensure the continuity of the student's studies, the applicable fees must be paid in full before the end of each term. Failure to pay these fees may jeopardise the student's continued studies at the LFSL.
- Each month started is due. In case of late arrival or early termination, LFSL will invoice the school fees proportionally for the enrolment period, on the basis of the whole month and in an amount equal to 1/10^e of the annual school fees per month started, plus any months of cancellation not respected.
- No refund of school fees will be made, in whole or in part, for a student enrolled at LFSL due to absence during the term or for reasons beyond the control of the school.
- The school must be informed in writing of any cancellation during the year, with three (3) months' notice. Late notification will result in additional charges (e.g. invoicing for the following term) equivalent to 1/10 of the annual school fee for each month of notice not respected. We encourage families to notify their cancellation as early as possible.

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- Multi-child families who enrol their children at LFSL are granted a reduction in school fees of 15% for the third child, 20% for the fourth child and 25% for the fifth and subsequent children (the reduction is applied in order of age).

Contributions from the Swedish authorities

- The reduced school fees listed on the website only apply to students for whom LFSL receives a grant from the Swedish authorities, known as *Skolpeng*.
- For the school to receive *Skolpeng*, the student must be *registered* with the Swedish Tax Agency and have received a Swedish Personal Identity Number (*personnummer*). It is the child's guardian's responsibility to ensure that he/she is registered with the Swedish Tax Agency (*folkbokfört*) and receives a *personnummer*.

Please note: If you delay in updating or registering the student's home address, you may not be entitled to a grant. The same applies if the Swedish tax authority refuses registration. This may affect the amount invoiced for school fees in proportion to the amount of the grant not received from the Swedish authorities. In all cases, the parents/guardians will be responsible for any shortfall.

- LFSL's fee policy is dependent on local regulations. The Foundation may therefore have to adjust the school fees in case of any changes in the Swedish authorities' regulations and laws regarding the allocation of grants. LFSL cannot be held responsible for any changes in these allocation principles, as these matters are the responsibility of the Swedish state and local authorities.

Invoicing and payments

- Annual school fees are invoiced per term (autumn/spring). The school may use third parties to invoice families.
- Payment terms: Guardians have 20 days from the date of the invoice to pay.
- All fees must be paid by the due date indicated on the invoice. Failure to pay all outstanding fees by the due date may jeopardise the student's continued studies at LFSL.
- Any family with a child leaving LFSL must ensure that any outstanding invoices are paid before leaving.
- In case of non-payment on the due date, a late fee and penalty interest will be charged. Invoices that remain unpaid after a reminder will be handed over to a Swedish debt collection agency.
- Families whose school fees are paid by a third party (company) must provide the school with the document "Financial Regulation with Third Party", duly completed, and signed by the third party. Families will be invoiced for any costs not covered by the third party. In all cases, guardians are jointly and severally liable.
- In case of an invoicing error or adjustment of the grants received from the Swedish authorities, LFSL will adjust the following invoice(s).
